








Meno a Kwena A quick overview

The Safari never stops at Meno a Kwena, a hidden gem of a camp perched on a rocky clifftop above the Boteti River.

The camp was originally used by Southern Africa's legendary explorers, it's refreshingly and stylishly simple. The real treat at Meno is the connection with nature. When you can game view straight from your private veranda, nothing else really matters.

Mokolwane A quick overview

Mokolwane is a secluded, adventure-filled camp in the remote Okavango Delta's Xudum concession. Surrounded by Mokolwane palms and 200,000 hectares of pristine wilderness, it's home to abundant wildlife, including one of Africa's highest leopard densities. As the only camp for miles, it offers unmatched solitude and an authentic safari experience.

We will have exclusive use of the whole camp!

Mokoro Trips

This trip can be done at any time of the day but it's particularly good in the morning, it lasts around 2 hours. The trip will depend upon the river level,



Game Drives

The diverse landscape is scattered with herds of elephant and large numbers of predators. With virtually no other people around you will enjoy remarkable game drives in the company of exceptional guides.



Bird Watching

Tick off a vast number of species unique to the Okavango Delta such as the Slaty Eagle, the Pel's Fishing Owl and the African Skimmer.









Two highlights at Mokolwane

Our transfer to and from Mokolwane will be by helicopter. A scenic flight over the Okavango Delta is a unique experience, offering breathtaking aerial views of its vast wetlands, winding waterways, and diverse wildlife.

Mokolwane is leopard country. These territorial cats love it here so much, that the area boasts the third highest density recorded anywhere in Africa. Mokolwane is a special little camp, big on adventure. And being the only camp for miles around, a great place to breath in the stillness and solitude.
